Activities

Mosaic Workshop

Mosaic is a form of decorative art that has been around for thousands of years, enjoying its hey-day during the Greek-Roman era. The technique uses fragments of diverse materials such as, stones, marble, semi-precious stones, flints and pebbles, glass pastilles, tiles, pieces of ceramic, and lots more. These are mounted onto different surfaces. Formerly, they were used to make pavements and cover walls but nowadays they can be adapted to cover any object. The instructor, Petra, is an occupational therapist by profession. Ten years ago, she started to work with mosaic when decorating her own house. Since then, she has researched and perfected her technique. She makes mosaics to order and teaches these techniques. She has frequently run workshops at the Museum do Trajo in S. Brás. Her motto is "let's be creative"!
